Sunday June 15th, 2008

Start: 8:30 a.m. for USAS swimmers
9:30 a.m. for Masters
All swims are deep water starts.
15 minutes prior to race start there will be a mandatory race briefing at the court house.
If the number of entries exceeds expectations, the meet director may divide male and female swimmers into waves for safety.

Entry Fee: Entry is \$35 for pre-registered athletes before 6-1-08. After 6-1-08 or race day registration is \$40. All participants will receive a swim cap. All pre-registered participants who register before 6-1-08 will receive a customized T-shirt. Athletes who register after 6-1-08 or on race day will receive a shirt until we run out.

Event Sanctioning: The 1-mile Masters swim is a USMS/PMS sanctioned event, while the USAS 1-mile swim is sanctioned by USA Swimming/CCS. All swimmers must be current 2008 registered members of one of these organizations in order to compete. Membership information may be obtained by contacting the numbers below.

Equipment: Use of neoprene swimsuits, wetsuits, or other non-porous attire shall result in that swimmer being ineligible for awards or place points. The use of fins, pull buoys, or other swimming devices will result in instant disqualification. Soft hand paddles may only be used as a prosthesis – provided, in the opinion of the Race Director – they do not present a safety hazard to other swimmers.

Awards: Unique awards will be given to top 3 male and female winners in each age group. Age group awards are in 5- year increments for USMS/PMS starting at 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, etc. For USA swimming/CCS we have the following age groups: 11-12, 13-14, 15-18. Swimmers under 11 years of age, who wish to participate, will need a letter from their USA swim coach stating they are physically able to complete a 1 mile open swim.

Special awards will be given to the top overall male & female finishers in the divisions: 1mile Masters, 1 mile USAS

Registration/Check-in

Registration and check-in opens at 7:00 a.m. Race-day registration will be available. We are not set up to accept credit cards. All entrants must mail a photocopy of either their USMS or USA Swimming card with the entry form or bring it to registration on race day. Sorry, no switching of events will be allowed. As per PMS rules, a \$3.00 look-up fee will be charged to those Masters participants who do not bring their USMS card or have not pre-mailed a copy of their card prior to the event. USA Swimmers who do not bring their card to registration, and who did not mail a photocopy of their card prior to the event, will not be allowed to participate.

Course & Water Temperature: The course will be marked by buoys at approximately 200 yard intervals. The expected water temperature of the lake is between 65-70 degrees. The 1-mile course is a rectangle course alongside the dam and back. Start and finish of the event are in the same place, by the Millerton Courthouse. It is suggested that you bring comfortable shoes to walk to the race start as surface will have some gravel, sand and rocks.

Water Safety: Swim caps will be provided to all swimmers and will be mandatory for the swim. The course will be monitored by a safety boat and paddlers. Individual escorts will not be allowed. A cut-off time will be enforced to ensure that no swimmers will be in the water longer than one hour for the 1-mile swim.

Directions: FWY 41 coming from the South: Take exit Friant road. Turn right at the traffic light – you are on Friant road. Stay on this road for the next 15 miles till you pass the small town of Friant. Go past the Shell station up to the dam and take a left at the top – follow the parking signs.

FWY 41 coming from the North: Take exit Friant road. Turn left at the traffic light – you are on Friant road. Stay on this road for the next 15 miles till you pass the small town of Friant. Go past the Shell station up to the dam and take a left at the top – follow the parking signs

This is a rain or shine event.
