35th Annual Roughwater Swim

Date: Saturday, August 2, 2008

Location: Lifeguard Tower #1, Santa Cruz City Main Beach.

Time: 11:00 A.M. Registration and Check-in begins at 9:30 A.M.

Course: Contestants receive a siren start, enter the ocean at Lifeguard Tower #3 on the east side of the Municipal Wharf, swim parallel to the pier, around the end, and then straight in to the finish in front of the Santa Cruz Coast Hotel above the beach on the west side of the pier. The course is one mile. Restrooms are available on the wharf and adjacent to the beach. **Three start waves** will be used this year: *Masters 18 to 39 years, first wave, Masters 40 years and up, second wave, Non-Masters 18 years and under, third wave.* Pre Race Instructions at 10:45.

Entry: \$25.00 per person if postmarked by Monday, July 21, 2008. Late or race day registration is \$30.00. All participants receive a commemorative item.

Eligibility: **ALL ENTERED SWIMMERS 18 YEARS AND UP must be currently registered with United States Masters Swimming.**** Registered Masters swimmers *must* send a copy of current 2008 registration card with entry. Non Registered swimmers *must* register with USMS (18 years and up) for \$35.00. Entries will not be accepted without this registration. USMS registration forms are available through **Pacific Masters Swimming** from Nancy Ridout at www.pacificmasters.org or 415.892.0771, and must be included with mailed entry or on race day.

**Swimmers 18 years old who belong to other swim organizations and who do not wish to join USMS will swim in the last heat and must declare on race day.

Divisions/Awards: Age groups:11-12, 13-14, 15-18. USMS: 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, etc., Mens and Womens. Medals 1st, through 3rd place. Contestants in wetsuits are **not** eligible for PMS points or awards.

Results: Timing and results by *Santa Cruz Track Club*.

Safety: Safety services provided by the Santa Cruz City Beach Lifeguard Service and Santa Cruz Surf Life Saving Association. All contestants are required to wear a day glow swim cap (provided). A one-hour cutoff time will be enforced. No personal escorts are permitted. Wetsuits, tri-suits and insulated swim caps permitted, no other swim aids allowed, however contestants in wetsuits are **not** eligible for USMS/PMS points or awards. The expected water temperature is 60 degrees.

Entry and Payment: Masters Swimmers send checks payable to **SCSLSA** for entry. Also, send your completed and signed USMS/PMS registration form and checks payable to PMS for swim eligibility if not registered with this swim organization. All ages mail entries to: *Santa Cruz Roughwater Swim, 323 Church Street, Santa Cruz, CA 95060*. Proceeds benefit Santa Cruz surf lifesaving efforts.

Mandatory Waivers of Liability

City of Santa Cruz: I, or my minor child _____, wish to enter and participate in the Roughwater Swim Event. I understand the dangers even for the most conditioned athlete. I understand that I should not enter this event unless I am in excellent health and am fully trained and conditioned for this strenuous task. I represent that I or my minor child is in proper physical condition for this event.

I am also aware the weather conditions that prevail in Monterey Bay at any time of the year, very cold water, dense fog, strong currents, pounding surf, treacherous sharks. I also understand that pleasure and fishing craft share the waters and may be a danger, and in addition, I specifically acknowledge that I am aware of all the risks in open water swimming and agree to assume those risks.

Nevertheless, with knowledge of these facts, and in consideration of acceptance of my entry, I, or my minor child, _____ intend to be legally bound for myself, heirs, executors and administrators, and hereby waive and forever discharge any and all rights and claims for damages which may occur to me against the Santa Cruz Surf Life Saving Association, Santa Cruz Aquatic Masters, USMS, PMS, The City of Santa Cruz, its employees and agents, and assigns, from all rights, claims, or liability for damage for any and all injuries to me or my property, arising out of, or in connection with my participation in this event.

I further agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless the above named parties against all claims, demands, and causes of action including court costs and attorney's fees, directly or indirectly arising from any action or proceeding brought by or prosecuted for my benefit. This release extends to all claim of every kind and nature whatsoever, whether, whether known or unknown, and I expressly waive any benefits I may otherwise have under Section 1542 of the Civil Code of California relating to the release of unknown claims.
